On December 12, 2006, a verification inspection was conducted of your establishment in accordance with the "Guam Safe" Partnership Agreement between the Guam Contractors Association and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration. The inspection included a comprehensive review of your safety and health program and a walk-through of your establishment to ensure that all the elements of the Agreement were being met.

This review has shown that your company has continued to show a commitment to this Partnership by maintaining an exemplary safety and health program. You have established a safety and health committee and demonstrated your personal commitment to it. You have continued to provide training opportunities. Periodic safety and health inspections are being conducted to identify and correct hazards, and to prevent potential injuries and illnesses. In addition, you have provided your employees a safe and healthful working environment in which they are free to raise safety concerns without fear of retaliation or intimidation. A jobsite safety inspection was conducted at the Alpha Bravo Wharf Improvement Project. The walk-through was conducted with company officials. Interviews with employees confirmed that your safety and health program and initiatives are working. There were no serious hazards revealed during this inspection.

During the next year, we expect that you will continue to maintain and improve the safety and health programs that you have already established. To assist you in your efforts, a copy of the partnership elements is attached.

We congratulate you on your continued participation in the "Guam Safe" Partnership Agreement and look forward to working with you in the coming year.
